## THE WEBB PRIZE

The annual Webb Prize of Three Hundred Dollars was instituted in 1887 by Dr. W. Seward Webb, of New York, to be awarded during the lifetime of the founder to the best landscape in the Exhibition, painted by an American artist under forty years of age. The award to be made by the Jury of each annual Exhibition, and not to be given to the same artist a second time.

In 1901 the limitation of age was removed, and the prize is now awarded for the best landscape or marine picture in the Exhibition painted by an American artist who has not already received the prize.

## THE SHAW FUND

The Shaw Fund of Fifteen Hundred Dollars was devoted to the purchase of a composition painted in oil by an American artist, containing one or more figures, to be selected by the Jury from the works in the annual Exhibition. The picture thus chosen became the property of Mr. Samuel T. Shaw, the donor of the fund.

In 1901 the Shaw Fund was withdrawn, and in its place Mr. Shaw founded the Shaw Prize of Three Hundred Dollars to be given annually for the best figure composition in the Exhibition, painted in oil by an American citizen and the property of the painter, portraits to be excluded. The prize was given by a vote of all the members of the Society present on Varnishing Day, a plurality vote deciding the award. This prize was awarded to William Sergeant Kendall for A Fairy Tale.

The Shaw Fund is now re-established. It consists of \$1,500 or more each year, which will be devoted to the purchase of one or more works of art by American artists. These works will be chosen with the assist-

ance of the Jury and will become the property of Mr. Shaw.

## THE CARNEGIE PRIZE

The annual prize of Five Hundred Dollars, instituted by Mr. Andrew Carnegie, is awarded by the jury for the most meritorious oil painting in the Exhibition by an American artist, portraits only excepted, the picture to be the property of the artist. The same artist may not receive the prize in two successive years, and not more than twice in all. The founder of the prize reserves an option for two days after the announcement of the award for the purchase of the prize picture at the listed price.

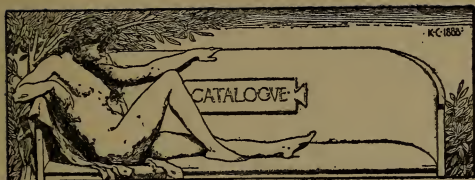
## THE JULIA A. SHAW MEMORIAL PRIZE

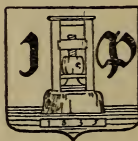

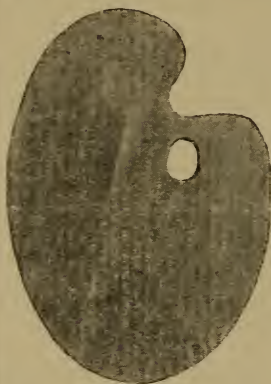
